



Behaviour Policy

All Scouts (Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorer Scouts) are expected to behave courteously and to respect themselves and others; good behaviour is an essential quality we expect of our Scouts at 1st Crownhill. Bullying and disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated. Disruptive behaviour can put the Scout and others at risk, particularly during outside activities and camp.

Should a child's behaviour be intolerable, a parent or guardian will be contacted and asked to remove their child from the section meeting or activity. Should behaviour or actions become severe the child may be asked to leave the group. Please see the Anti-Bullying Policy for more information on behaviour expectations.
