



Use of Images Policy

As many of our activities (such as camping and hiking, etc.) do not involve many parents, it is always nice for us to record the children taking part in activities. Videos and images may be displayed in the Scout Hut, on our 1st Crownhill website or on our Facebook page and are subject to the regulations of the Data Protection Act 1998 and the Human Rights Act 1998. Our aims are:

- To ensure, where necessary, consent has been given prior to the taking and use of images during Scout activities, particularly where they show Scouts.
- To ensure such images are used in a manner respectful of the eight data protection principles as defined in our policy. A full version of this policy is held on our notice board but additional copies are available for you to take home, simply ask your section leader.

Rather than ask for your consent for each activity your child undertakes, we ask you to say yes or no to general use of images on the yearly permission form. Exceptions may include a photo being featured in the newspaper, for use on the website or for other advertising purposes.

Parents and guardians have the right to request that pictures of their child be taken down off social media or display in the hut.
